**Hellbrunn Castle**  
In 1612, prince-archbishop Markus Sittikus commissioned cathedral architect Santino Solari to construct the Hellbrunn castle *ad paupores*, which counts among the most splendid Renaissance buildings north of the Alps. Today, the castle with its extensive park, permanent exhibition "Schauwelt" and the famous "trick fountains", you can still experience the same fun as the builder with his guests once: mysterious, mystical grilles, water-powered moving figures and deceitful fountains in all corners of the castle. **Salzburg Open-Air Museum**  
On the 50 ha large grounds amidst the Untersberg, the open-air museum in Salzburg's neighbouring town of Grödig, more than 100 historic original buildings, farm equipment, household tools from industry are visited. A 7 km long network of hiking trails and footpaths connects

more than 600 years of rural history. The 2 km long **mountain railway** also provides

confidentiality in the high peaks of the museum landscape. Riding on the train is included in the admission fee. The mountain railway "Säuleit" offers food and drink and features a large pub garden - and its own train shop.

**Pilgrimage Basilica Maria Plain**  
Maria Plain in the north of the City of Salzburg has been a popular pilgrimage destination since the 17th century. The **Basilica** built by prince-archbishop Max Gandolf von Kuenburg in 1674 is not just a landmark of Bergheim, and popular pilgrimage destination, but also offers visitors a unique

panorama across Salzburg all the way to the Alps. In appreciation of the Marian shrine and the coronation of the miraculous image, W. Mozart composed the famous "Coronation Mass". A pilgrimage trail with 15 wayside crosses from 1705

As a popular destination steeped in legend, Untersberg offers a wide range of hiking trails, a ski slope, a circular cycling route, challenging climbing tours, viewpoints and a cozy lodge at the summit area. But the real appeal of this mountain lies in its enchanting atmosphere. The **Untersberg**

cable car - on aerial cable way operating year-round - invites visitors from the lower terminus in Grödig/St. Leonhard up to the 1.853 m high panoramic mountain.
